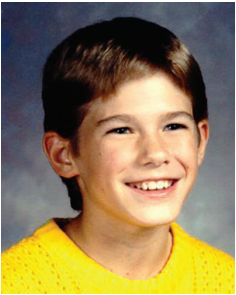


The Jacob Wetterling Documentary

In October 1989, eleven-year-old Jacob Wetterling was abducted on a quiet road in St. Joseph, Minnesota. The mystery of what happened to Jacob haunted us for decades, and the impacts of his abduction were felt far and wide.

For nearly four years, a team of Minnesota filmmakers, led by Emmy-winning director Chris Newberry, has been filming this story and documenting history as breaking news in the case unfolded. Now it's time to craft those hours of raw footage into a gripping and inspiring film.

The goal is to get the film in front of a national audience – to share Jacob's story in a thoughtful way and to examine the amazing ripple effects of his life and legacy. The filmmakers have worked closely with Jacob's parents, Patty and Jerry Wetterling, as well as other key people from the 27-year investigation, the Jacob Wetterling Resource Center, and several other partner organizations.

In April 2019, the filmmaking team launched a fundraising campaign to help move the project into its final stages. As of May 21, 2019, the fundraising campaign had succeeded in reaching half of its \$100,000 goal. Now, we're asking for your help.
